## **CH Mack Named On Inc. 5000 List Of America's Fastest-Growing Private Companies**

**Cincinnati, Ohio** — Inc. Magazine ranked CH Mack, Inc. 1,676 on its fourth annual list of America's fastest-growing private companies, among other companies such as Pandora, 7-Eleven and Radio Flyer.

"The leaders of the companies on this year's Inc. 5000 have figured out how to grow their businesses during the longest recession since the Great Depression," said Inc. President Bob LaPointe.

Founded in 1993, CH Mack creates IT solutions that enable increased productivity, compliance and efficiency for organizations within health and government sectors with a focus on managed care entities.

The result for customers has been a dramatic shift in ability to supply better healthcare and give quality of life, while reducing the cost burden for both individuals and our healthcare system. The effect for CH Mack has been a jump in revenue, resulting in 169 percent growth over the last three years. In December of 2009 the company was awarded the Fast 55 Award, naming it among the fastest growing companies in the Greater Cincinnati area.

Chris Boue, President and CEO, has focused the company on creating substantial value for patients, providers, and payers by building next-generation systems in an integrated medical-management platform.

In total, the companies on the Inc. 5000 have created 1.4 million jobs. The Health sector is the top employer with 287,726 jobs, followed by Business Products & Services (230,066), Food & Beverage (108,344) and Human Resources (107,924).
